

Online Examination Rules

If an applicant violates the Admission Rules or the rules for conducting entrance examinations established by this Procedure during the entrance examinations, the examiner has the right to terminate the entrance examination and assign a score of 0 points for the corresponding subject, regardless of the amount of work completed.

During the entrance examinations conducted using remote technologies, applicants **are prohibited from:**

- using any sources of information not provided for by the (books, textbooks, reference books, summaries, notes and records on paper and electronic media, as well as other sources, internet resources, etc.);
- using communication devices and headphones/earbuds;
- using additional computing and communication devices, other than those used to connect to the video conferencing system;
- the presence of unauthorized persons in the room;
- impersonation/substitution of the applicant;
- providing access to the testing to third parties;
- turning off the webcam and microphone;
- any communication by the applicant;
- leaving their workspace;
- recording in any way the materials and content of the entrance examination, as well as transferring them to third parties;
- using audio, visual, or other prompts.

During the entrance examination, applicants **must comply** with the following rules:

- The webcam must be positioned directly in front of the face; placing the camera to the side is not allowed.
- The head must be fully visible within the frame; partial or complete movement out of the camera's field of view is not permitted.
- The face must be in the center of the webcam's viewing area and occupy at least 10% of the space captured by the camera throughout the entire session.
- The face must be evenly lit; the light source must not be directed at the camera or illuminate only one half of the face.
- Hair, clothing, hands, or anything else must not cover the facial area.
- Wearing sunglasses is not allowed; only glasses with clear lenses may be used.
- There must be no voices or noise in the background; the entrance examination must take place in silence.
- The entrance examination must be taken in a browser with the window maximized to full screen; switching to other applications (including other browsers) or minimizing the browser is not allowed, and opening third-party tabs (pages) is prohibited.
- All programs that use the webcam, except for the browser, must be turned off on the computer.
